On a holiday-shortened trading week, live cattle traded at mostly \$155 in the South, \$4 higher than last week. Trade was \$155 - \$157 in the North, \$243 - \$246 dressed, also \$2 - \$4 higher than last week.

The Fed Cattle Exchange listed 2,560 head for the week. Bids on Tuesday were at \$151.25 but increased Wednesday as 459 head sold on active bidding at prices up to \$155.00 for southern heifers and \$155.25 for southern steers.

Live Cattle futures traded steady to slightly higher for the week. Feeder Cattle futures were steady for the week as most livestock markets were closed or had limited market runs.
